Whenever we find a rare four-leafed, shamrock clover, we get excited! Why? Because shamrocks are lucky! But, what makes a shamrock lucky?

Centuries ago, a group of people called the Druids believed that the four-leaf clover would keep bad spirits away. Other groups of people believed finding a four-leaf clover would bring them good luck as long as they had it in their possession. 

Finding a pot of gold would be so very lucky! Think of what you could do with all of the gold you would find!


